Notes:

- The roles of orderly and ambulance transport seem to be interchangeable. Men would be employed within the hospital and transporting patients from railway station to the hospital.
- Men were peripatetic with members from both Chippenham and Corsham detachments employed at Bowood, Chippenham and Corsham. When heavy casualties were expected they were also called to convey patients from Bath railway station to the military hospital at Royal United in Bath.
